



Having lived in Japan, Danish painter **EGE ARP-HANSEN** has been influenced by their arts – both ancient and modern – along with those of China and Korea in the development of his meditative painting style. Infinity and monochromes fascinate him. This can be seen when he investigates a single pigment in its nuances. In some paintings the motif appears almost invisible however the complexity slowly unfolds. They need a moment of quietude and an open mind to evolve. In other works the colours vibrate intensively almost sensually but it still takes time and attention to reveal their deeper qualities.
